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NJ Medicaid ACO Demonstration Project

August 2011:
Legislation is passed to establish the Medicaid ACO Demo. Project

- Sponsored by Senator Vitale
- Informed by a work group led by Dr. Jeff Brenner and the Camden Coalition of Healthcare Providers

May 2013:
Regulations proposed
May 2014:
Regulations adopted

- Confirmed multi-stakeholder governance structure
- Reinforced participation requirements of hospitals, PCPs, behavioral health providers and community organizations

July 2014:
Applications due

- Initially pursued by eight communities
- Informed by the research and market scan of the Rutgers Center for State Health Policy

July 2015:
Demonstration Project Commences

- Certified ACOs will commence or, in some cases, continue providing enhanced care management services to better meet the needs of their most complex and vulnerable patients and reduce systemic costs



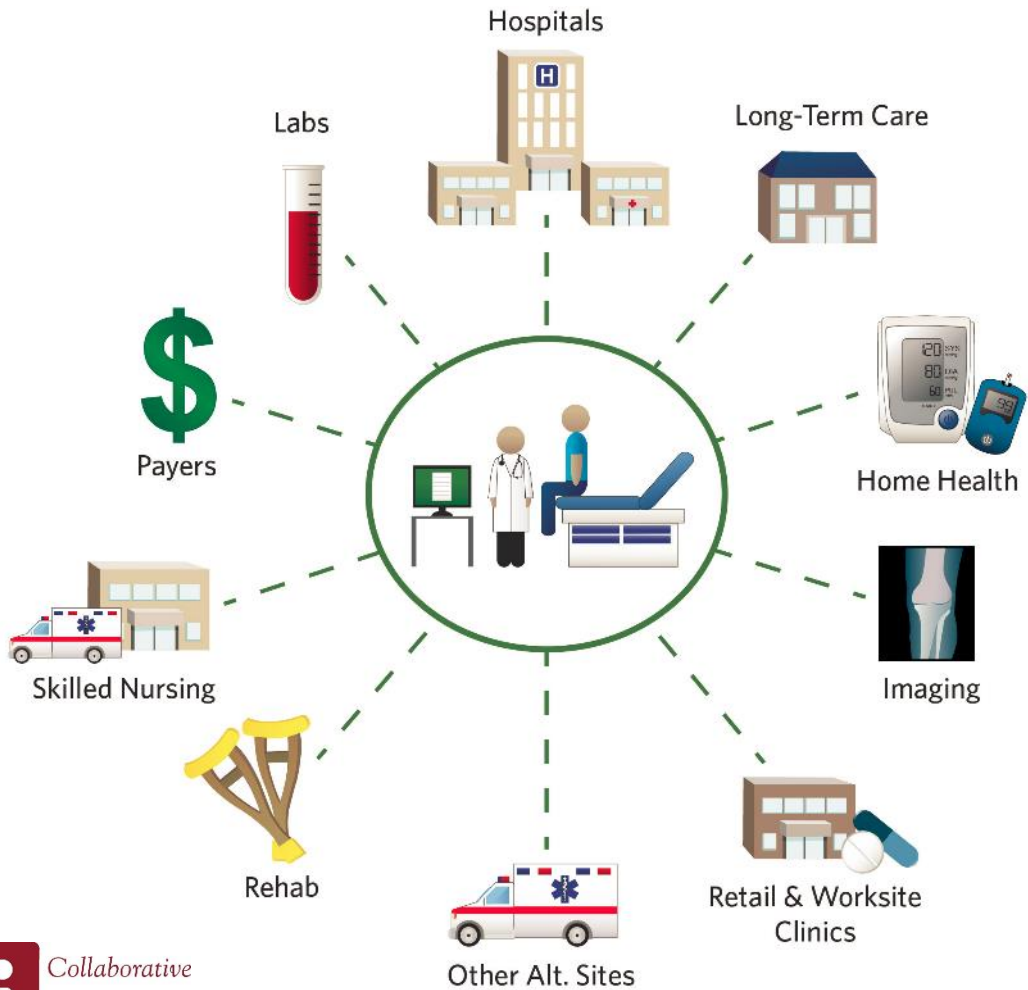
