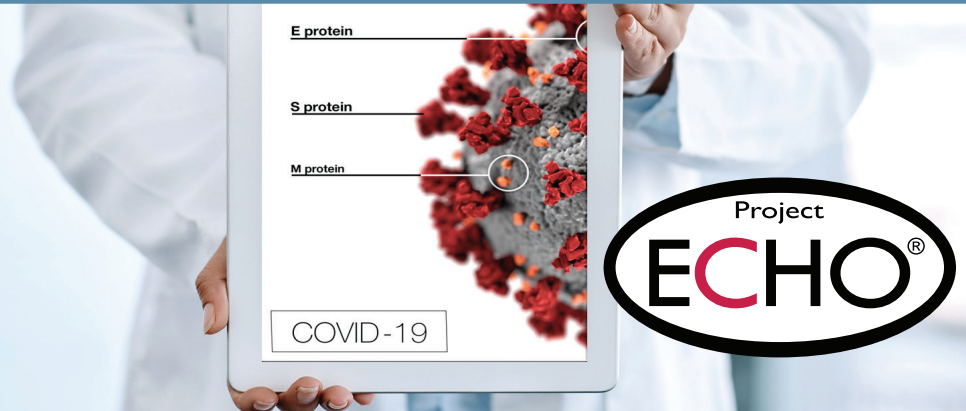


COVID-19 VIDEO CONFERENCE SESSION
